

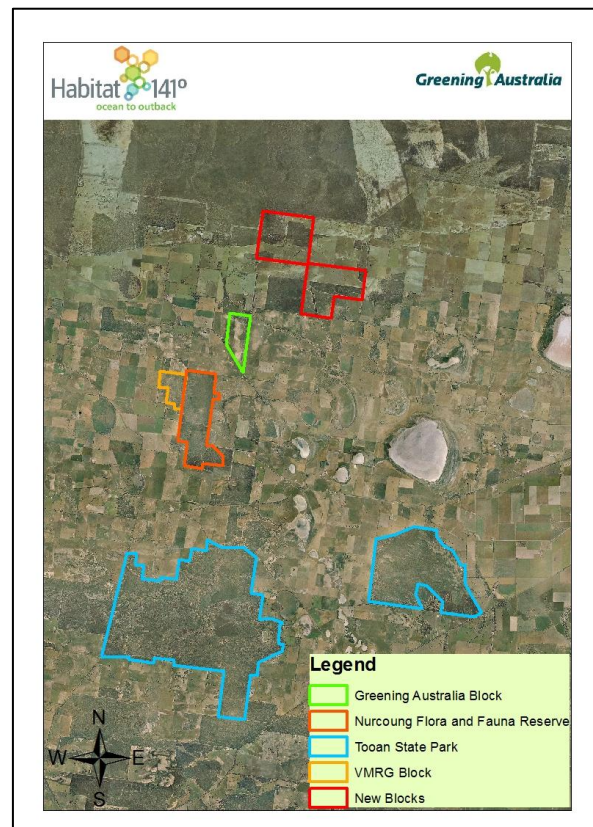
Alcoa invests \$1million for Habitat 141°!

Greening Australia welcomes renewed funding commitment from long term corporate partner, Alcoa. Having invested over the past three years in carbon yield, restoration research and community engagement within zone 1 & 2 of Habitat 141 they are now turning their attention to achieving on-ground outcomes. Specifically 200 hectares of biodiverse restoration in zone 2 and 133 hectares within the zone 1 planned corridors.

Option no. 1 - Advancement of the Nurcough Malleefowl Corridor

This is an excellent opportunity to establish an icon H141 restoration site that reconnects core remnant vegetation and builds upon the good work already achieved by partners in the Habitat 141 movement. An opportunity to do just that exists within the Nurcough Malleefowl Corridor.

Negotiations with Trust for Nature are progressing in regards to these new blocks however remains a proposal at this stage and I encourage proposals from other organisations on how best to maximise this investment and achieve the greatest outcome.
